Coaches Corner

With the Club enjoying a break as a result of the bye it is good to catch our breath.

The first game of the year probably gave us a false impression of where we were and as we are aware the next three games saw us well behind the 8 ball.

We were very poor against Port. I did think the signs were better for a half against Central and with West I felt we were the better team on the day but didn't capitalise on the scoreboard. Since then we have had good results against Glenelg, Sturt and South again.

The nature of the draw however means we haven't played North or Norwood yet. North is a fore runner in the competition and I believe Norwood are a top 5 team this year. As such until we get over the next 3 games, (we play Central after the above 2) I don't think we can truly gauge where we are in the context of the season. At that stage we would have played 10 games and then we will probably be able to judge our standing.

The good thing so far though is the solid form from a host of young players who have been brought in because of the injuries to Colville, Cicolella, Inkster and Schwarze.

Our backline has consisted of a group of players with not a lot of experience. I talk of Salter, Fairclough, Hier, Stewart and Redden. Without counting them I would suggest their total games wouldn't make it much past 30 but their football has been of a very consistent nature. It has been very reassuring and all goes well for the future of the Club that our defence can look forward to some continuity with quality and toughness.

It is hoped that we will have some of those injured players filter back in although it is disappointing for Gavin and us that he will be missing for about a month with a broken bone in his wrist.

The next time I report will have seen us about 2/3rds of the way into the season.

I am sure a lot will be known about what we are doing and what we have done then.

Our goal is to establish ourselves in the top 3 but I do believe the battle for these spots is a lot more competitive than in the past few years.

As I said I think Norwood are better equipped, North and Port are solid, Sturt have become competitive again and of course Central are setting a pretty hot pace. West, Glenelg and South are just off the pace at the moment but are capable of, if not making the top 3, certainly helping to shape it.

It just means we have to keep working to improve our game. That is what we will be endeavouring to do over the next couple of months.

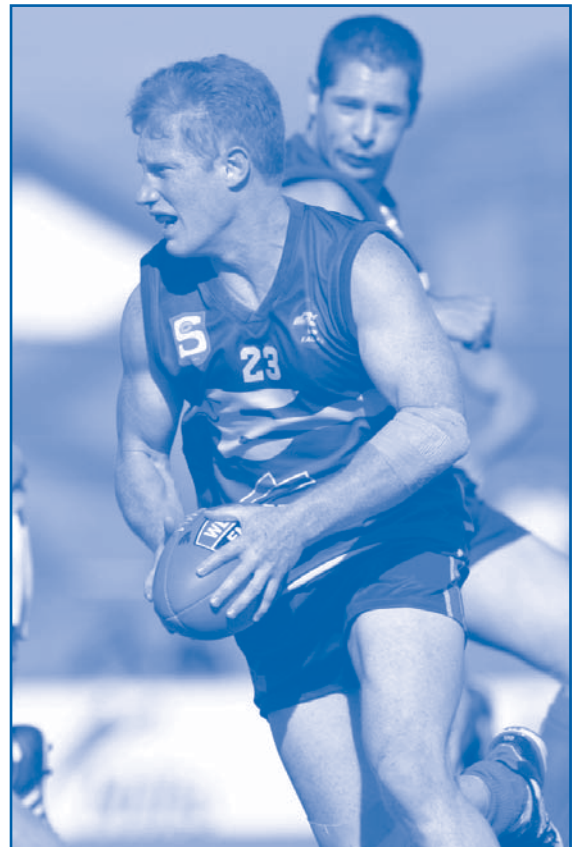
