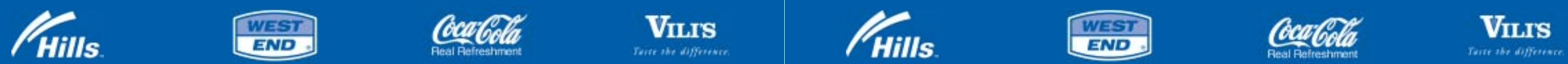

The Eagles Football Academy (EFA) is an innovative program that will provide an opportunity for all junior footballers and coaches from within the WWTC promotional zone to improve their football skills and knowledge. The principle role of the academy is to identify and develop talented junior footballers within our promotional zone and provide them with a pathway to play football at the highest level.

It is a requirement of the SANFL that all League Clubs provide a development squad program for footballers in the age groups of Under 13, 14 & 15 years. During our annual discussions with key stakeholders from clubs within our metropolitan zone it became obvious that there are some real concerns at the amount of football some juniors are playing and the time commitment required by their families to do so.

To address this concern the EFA program will be structured to ensure minimal disruptions to School and Club football competitions whilst also ensuring that academy participants receive coaching and information of the highest quality.

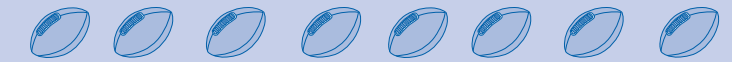
We are pleased to announce that Steve Winstanley has been appointed Head Coach of the Academy. Steve brings an enormous amount of junior coaching experience and local knowledge into this role which will benefit the program greatly.

In his role as Head Coach Steve will attend local football games to build a rapport and liase with all clubs and coaches in an endeavour to further identify talented footballers capable of participating in the academy.

Involvement in the EFA culminates with its most talented participants representing the WWTC Under 15 squad competing in the 'Camry Crows Cup' during the school holidays in July each year. From here they will be encouraged to progress to the Eagles Under 17 squad and beyond.

Opportunities will also be given to the most talented participants in the Under 13 & 14 age groups to represent the Eagles.

As a club we are committed to having as many local players as possible represent the Eagles at senior level. We trust that the Eagles Football Academy program will enable us to fulfil this goal and remain a force at all levels in the SANFL for many years to come.

Eagles Country League Progress

With SANFL finals underway and most country leagues into Grand Final time it seems appropriate to report and reflect on the season thus far.

There have been some fantastic individual achievements in 2004 from country players representing our club at all levels.

David Westbrook (Kadina – YPFL) has continued his Mail Medal winning form from 2003 to make his league debut, be selected in the State Under 20 representative team and receive an invitation to attend the AFL Draft State screening in October. After his debut early in the season David has become an integral part of the Eagles on-ball rotation.

Scott McMahon (CMS Crows – YPFL) after starting the year in Under 19's was promoted to the reserves and selected to represent SA in the National Under 18 championships in Melbourne. Scott had a fantastic carnival, which culminated in his selection in the All-Australian team and an invitation to the AFL draft camp in Melbourne during September.

Nick Salter (South Clare – NEFL) still an Under 17 player started the year representing Australia v Ireland. He was also selected to represent SA in the National Under 18 championships in Melbourne and is still eligible for this team in 2005. On returning from these championships Nick has progressed to Under 19's and Reserves.

Brendan Papps (Kadina – YPFL) and Ben Arbon (Crystal Brook) were both selected to

represent SA in the National Under 16 championships held in Adelaide.

Of the 74 players to represent the Eagles at Underage level in 2004, 31 are from our country zone. The NEFL has provided 13 players, YPFL (10), APFL (6) and NAFA (2). Many of these players have formed our leadership group in 2004 with Brodie Lomas (South Clare) being our Under 19 captain.
